

RESOLUTION NO. 2014- 22

A RESOLUTION AWARDDING OPEN-END CONTRACTS FOR THE FURNISHING AND DELIVERY OF HID STREET LIGHTING AND VARIOUS ACCESSORIES, FOR THE VINELAND MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC UTILITY – DISTRIBUTION DIVISION, ON AN INDIVIDUAL LINE ITEM BASIS TO THE RESPECTIVE LOW BIDDERS AS PROVIDED IN THE SPECIFICATIONS.

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland has heretofore advertised for bids for the furnishing and delivery of HID Street Lighting and Various Accessories for the Vineland Municipal Electric Utility – Distribution Division, for a period of one year from date of award, with option for a second year, in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the Purchasing Agent; and

WHEREAS, on December 10, 2013, bids were received, duly opened and read aloud, being referred to the Business Administrator for tabulation, evaluation, report and recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the Business Administrator has, under date of January 7, 2014, submitted a written report and tabulation of the bids received and has recommended that open-end contracts for the furnishing and delivery of HID Street Lighting and Various Accessories for the Vineland Municipal Electric Utility – Distribution Division, be awarded on an individual line item basis to the respective low bidders as provided in the specifications as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Comptroller has certified that the funds for the contract to be awarded herein are available.
