

ORDINANCE NO. 2014 26

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR NO PARKING RESTRICTIONS ALONG SEVENTH STREET.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer’s Office has recommended that parking be prohibited along Seventh Street; and

WHEREAS, said recommendation has the concurrence of the Vineland Police Department and the City Solicitor and is considered to be in the best interest of the City of Vineland; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VINELAND THAT:

**SECTION 1.** No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets:

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Side</b>	<b>Location</b>
Seventh Street	West	From the northerly curblineline of Wood Street to the southerly curblineline of Plum Street
Seventh Street	East	From a point 153 feet north of the northerly curblineline of Wood Street to a point 90 feet northerly thereof

**SECTION 2.** Signs shall be erected and maintained as authorized by the Commissioner of Transportation of the State of New Jersey.

**SECTION 3.** All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.

Request for No Parking Ordinance



Per your request, our office has evaluated the on-street parking on North Seventh Street between Wood and Plum Streets.

As a result, it was found that there is no Ordinance prohibiting parking on the westerly side of the street where vehicles line up to enter the drive-thru of the customer service window. The queuing on the roadway should not be considered to be a parked scenario as the vehicles are truly in line for the municipal service. The westerly side should have no parking permitted.

Additionally, it would be of value to prohibit parking on the easterly side between the two existing driveways.

Please prepare an Ordinance establishing No Parking along a portion of Seventh Street as follows:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Location</u>
Seventh Street	West	From the northerly curbline of Wood Street to the southerly curbline of Plum Street
Seventh Street	East	From a point 153 feet north of the northerly curbline of Wood Street to a point 90 feet northerly thereof

The physical area of the eastern restriction is between the two existing driveways.
