A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXCLUSION OF THE PUBLIC FROM A MEETING BETWEEN THE CITY COUNCIL, CITY CLERK AND STAFF, ASSISTANT BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR, CITY SOLICITOR AND STAFF OF THE LEGAL DEPARTMENT, LAW FIRM OF DECOTIIS, FITZPATRICK AND COLE AND STAFF, AND CHIEF TIMOTHY CODISPOTI, CONCERNING MATTERS REGARDING PENDING LITIGATION OR ANTICIPATED LITIGATION IN WHICH THE PUBLIC BODY IS OR MAY BECOME A PARTY AND AUTHORIZING THE DISCLOSURE OF MINUTES OF SAID MEETING AS PROVIDED HEREIN.

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12, Open Public Meetings Act, permits the exclusion of the public from the meeting of a public body where the subject matter of that meeting involves pending or anticipated litigation in which the public body is or may become a party; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Vineland desires to meet with the City Clerk and staff, Assistant Business Administrator, City Solicitor and staff, the Law Firm of DeCotiis, FitzPatrick and Cole and staff, and Chief Timothy Codispoti concerning the matters of Gami Cruz vs. City of Vineland and City Council of the City of Vineland vs Mayor Bermudez.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Vineland that:

1. The public shall be excluded from a meeting of the Council of the City of Vineland on July 28, 2015 immediately following the Regular Meeting of City Council, in the Caucus Room, City Hall, Vineland.
2. The general nature of the subject matters of the closed meeting shall pertain to pending or anticipated litigation in which the public body is or may become a part regarding as set forth herein above.
3. Disclosure of the minutes of the closed meeting authorized above between the Council of the City of Vineland, City Clerk and staff, Assistant Business Administrator, City Solicitor and staff, Law Firm of DeCotiis, FitzPatrick and Cole and staff, and Chief Timothy Codispoti shall be made following a final decision and determination of said matter excepting information which must remain private.
4. It is anticipated that the minutes of the deliberation conducted in closed session may be disclosed to the public within on hundred eighty (180) days, however, any personal confidential information may not be released.
