A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXCLUSION OF THE PUBLIC FROM A MEETING BETWEEN CITY COUNCIL, THE MAYOR, CITY CLERK, ASSISTANT BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR AND STAFF, CITY COMPTROLLER, CITY SOLICITOR AND THE CITY'S LABOR ATTORNEYS CONCERNING COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AND AUTHORIZING DISCLOSURE OF MINUTES OF SAID MEETING.

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12, Open Public Meetings Act, permits the exclusion of the public from the meeting of a public body where the subject matter of that meeting involves any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Vineland desires to meet with the Mayor, City Clerk, Assistant Business Administrator and staff, City Comptroller, City Solicitor and the City's Labor Attorneys concerning terms and conditions of the FMBA-49 collective bargaining agreement, including negotiation positions, in which the public body is or may become a party.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Vineland that:

- 1. The public shall be excluded from a meeting of the Council of the City of Vineland on August 11, 2015, in the Caucus Room, City Hall, Vineland, NJ, immediately following adoption of this resolution, at which point the regular Council meeting shall take a brief recess in order for the closed meeting to be held.
- 2. The general nature of the subject matters of the closed meeting shall pertain to terms and conditions of the FMBA-49 collective bargaining agreement, including negotiation positions, in which the public body is or may become a party.
- 3. Disclosure of the minutes of the closed meeting authorized above between the Council of the City of Vineland, the Mayor, City Clerk, Assistant Business Administrator and staff, City Comptroller, City Solicitor and the City's Labor Attorneys shall be made following a final decision and determination of said matter.
- 4. The City Clerk at the present public meeting shall read the title of said resolution aloud so that members of the public in attendance can understand as precisely as possible the nature of the matter that will privately be discussed.
- 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
- 6. The City Clerk, on the next business day following this meeting, shall furnish a copy of the resolution to any member of the public who requests one at the fees allowed by N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1, et seq.
