

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-380

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING PERMISSION OF THE DIRECTOR, DIVISION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICES, N.J. DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS, TO DEDICATE BY RIDER PURSUANT TO (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-62.1) STORM RECOVERY RESERVES.

WHEREAS, permission is required of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services for approval as a dedication by rider of revenues received by a municipality when the revenue is not subject to reasonable accurate estimates in advance; and

WHEREAS, P.L. 2001, c. 138 permits municipalities to lapse unexpended balances budgeted annually for snow removal and other storm recovery costs; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-39 provides that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services may approve expenditures of monies by dedication by rider;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Vineland, County of Cumberland, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The governing body hereby requests permission of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to pay expenditures for Storm Recovery created in accordance with the provisions of P.L. 2001, c. 138 as per N.J.S.A. 40A:4-39.
2. The Municipal Clerk of the City of Vineland is hereby directed to forward two (2) certified copies of this resolution to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services
