## ORDINANCE NO. 2017-8

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2006-53, AS AMENDED, CHAPTER 29 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF VINELAND ENTITLED DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2006, the City Council of the City of Vineland adopted Ordinance 2006-53, as amended, creating the Vineland Development Corporation in order to assist in the revitalization of the city encourage private investment and assist in economic development; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 29, Section 29-3, sets forth the number and qualifications of the members of the Board of Directors of the Vineland Development Corporation; and

WHEREAS, the present Board of Directors has recommended changing the number of the Board members from 9 members to 7 members, and further to amend the qualifications as follows; (1) the Mayor (2) one member of City Council (3) two residents of the City of Vineland (4) two Business owners or professionals maintaining a principal office in the Vineland Urban Enterprise Zone and (5) one member of a nonprofit organization whose mission is to promote economic development and investment in the City of Vineland; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it to be in the best interest of the City and the Vineland Development Corporation to amend Chapter 29, Section 29-3 of the Code of the City of Vineland in accordance with the recommendations of the Board of Directors of the Vineland Development Corporation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Vineland that Chapter 29 Section 29-3A and Section 29-3B shall be deleted in their entirety and replaced as follows:

Section 29-3A. The Board of Directors shall consist of 7 members.

Section 29-3B. Selection of the members of the Board of Directors shall be made by the Mayor of the City of Vineland with the advice and consent of the Council of the City of Vineland. Members of the Board of Directors shall be selected from the following areas: the Mayor, one member of City Council, 2 residents of the City of Vineland, 2, business owners or professionals maintaining a principal office in the Vineland Urban Enterprise Zone and one member of a nonprofit organization whose mission is to promote economic development and investment in the City of Vineland.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any Ordinance or portions thereof that are inconsistent herewith shall be deleted and void to the extent of such inconsistencies and the terms of this Ordinance shall supersede the same.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication according to Law.
