RESOLUTION NO. 2019 - 112	
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A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ADVANCEMENT OF THREE CITY OF VINELAND ROADWAY CORRIDORS FOR SUBSTANTIVE SAFETY ANALYSIS TO ACCESS FEDERAL HIGHWAY SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FUNDS.

WHEREAS, New Jersey has been designated by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) as a Focus State for Pedestrians and Bicycles due to its disproportionally high and increasing number of serious injury and fatal crashes among bicyclists and pedestrians; and

WHEREAS, bicycles and pedestrians are involved in 2.9% of crashes, but 21.6% of fatal and serious injury crashes in Cumberland County; and

WHEREAS, the South Jersey Transportation Planning Organization (SJTPO) has conducted bicycle and pedestrian crash data analyses associated with a Countywide Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety Action Plan to provide local access to federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funds, through the State's Local Safety Program; and

WHEREAS, these analyses have identified:

- 1. The Chestnut Avenue corridor, between Second Street and Myrtle Street as the highest ranked corridor in Vineland and the County for Bicycle and Pedestrian crashes; and
- 2. The East Avenue corridor, between Florence Avenue and Plum Street as the second highest ranked corridor in Vineland for Bicycle and Pedestrian crashes; and
- 3. The Chestnut Avenue corridor between State Street and Holmes Avenue as the seventh highest ranked corridor in Vineland for Bicycle and Pedestrian crashes, and is interconnected with the top ranked section of Chestnut Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP), is a data-driven program tasked with advancing substantive safety improvements to maximize safety rather than simply meet minimum standards; and

WHEREAS, advancing the three above noted project locations with HSIP funding will permit the SJTPO to conduct detailed analyses, data collection, public outreach, and stakeholder collaboration in partnership with the City; and

WHEREAS, the goal of the next phase of SJTPO's technical effort will identify and ultimately recommend safety improvements along these corridors with the purpose of maximizing safety at these high crash locations without the contribution of any matching funds from the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the City of Vineland do hereby support the SJTPO effort to analyze and recommend safety improvements along the Chestnut Avenue and East Avenue corridors, which will allow the City to access federal HSIP funds to advance safety projects along these corridors to maximize safety.
