

RESOLUTION NO. 2019- 267

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT AWARD TO A STATE CONTRACT VENDOR, ASPHALT PAVING SYSTEMS, HAMMONTON, NJ FOR THE 2019 PAVEMENT PRESERVATION PROGRAM, IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$348,957.94.

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-12 and N.J.A.C. 5:34-7.29(c), may by resolution and without advertising for bids, purchase any goods or services under the State of New Jersey Cooperative Purchasing Program for any State contracts entered into on behalf of the State by the Division of Purchase and Property in the Department of the Treasury; and

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland intends to enter into a contract with a State Contract Vendor for the 2019 Pavement Preservation Program, through this resolution and properly executed contracts, which shall be subject to all the conditions applicable to the current State contracts;

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that a contract be awarded to Asphalt Paving Systems, Hammonton, NJ (17GNSV2-00181 and 19DPP00317), in an amount not to exceed \$348,957.94; and

WHEREAS, the availability of funds for said contract to be awarded herein have been certified by the Chief Financial Officer; and

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland has certified that this meets the statute and regulations governing the award of said contracts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VINELAND, as follows:

1. THAT this contract for the 2019 Pavement Preservation Program is awarded pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-12a and N.J.A.C. 5:34-7.29(c), under the State of New Jersey Cooperative Purchasing Program.
2. THAT the Purchasing Agent be and the same is hereby authorized to issue a contract to Asphalt Paving Systems, Hammonton, NJ, for the 2019 Pavement Preservation Program, in an amount not to exceed \$348,957.94.

2019 PAVEMENT PRESERVATION PROGRAM

The City Engineer's office is implementing a pavement preservation program to extend the useful life of fourteen (14) roads (approximately 4.1 miles). This method, called "Cape Seal", uses stone and asphaltic material, in two thin layers. The overall thickness will be about ½ inch thick. Before that, significant cracks will be sealed and significant potholes will be repaired.

This work does not include concrete curb, sidewalks, or driveways of any kind. It does not include drainage improvements. It does not include replacing or upgrading of signs, nor installation of new signs.

Areas in need of drainage improvements are being addressed in a separate contract.

Generally speaking, this year's program includes all streets within the rectangle of Park Avenue, West Avenue, Oak Road, and Northwest Boulevard. Those boundary roads, however, will not be a part of the project.

Fenimore Street and Mt. Vernon Avenue are being excluded from the project due to needed upgrades of water service lines. The Water Utility will be performing these upgrades in the coming year so that, in 2020, we can provide this same treatment to those streets.

Also, Summit Street between West Avenue and Second Street is being excluded due to its poor condition. It will be included in this year's Road Program, instead.

This neighborhood was selected because the majority of streets have a Pavement Condition Index (PCI) of Fair (56-70), which is required for this type of life extending treatment. It is expected that it will extend the useful life of these streets by up to ten (10) years.
