RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AWARD OF CONTRACT TO A STATE CONTRACT VENDOR, AURORA ENVIRONMENTAL INC., UNION BEACH, NJ FOR A FUEL TEMPORARY TANK SYSTEM AND GASBOY ISLANDER PLUS READER WITH EMERGENCY SHUT OFF FOR THE WALNUT ROAD FACILITY.

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40a:11-12 and N.J.A.C. 5:34-7.29(C), may by resolution and without advertising for bids, purchase any goods or services under the State of New Jersey Cooperative Purchasing Program for any State contracts entered into on behalf of the Division of Purchase and Property in the Department of the Treasury; and

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland intends to enter into a contract with a State Contract Vendor for a Fuel Temporary Tank System and Gasboy Islander Plus Reader with Emergency Shut Off for the Walnut Road Facility, through this resolution and properly executed contracts, which shall be subject to all the conditions applicable to the current State contracts; and

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that a contract be awarded to Aurora Environmental Inc., Union Beach, NJ (A42274) for a Fuel Temporary Tank System and Gasboy Islander Plus Reader with Emergency Shut Off, in an amount not to exceed \$118,150.00, in accordance with the quote from Aurora Environmental Inc., attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified the availability of funds for said contract to be awarded; and

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland has certified that this meets the statute and regulations governing the award of said contracts.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Vineland as follows:

That this contract for a Fuel Temporary Tank System and Gasboy Islander Plus Reader with Emergency Shut Off for the Walnut Road Facility, from Aurora Environmental Inc., Union Beach, NJ is awarded pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-12a and N.J.A.C. 5:34-7.29(c), under the State of New Jersey Cooperative Purchasing Program.
2. That the Purchasing Agent be and the same is hereby authorized to issue a contract to Aurora Environmental Inc., Union Beach, NJ in the amount not to exceed \$118,150.00.

<p>Aurora is pleased to provide the following proposal for providing temporary fuel aboveground storage tanks for both gasoline and diesel fuel. Aurora will provide and install two (2) 6,900 gallon double-walled aboveground storage tanks. Each tank will be double-walled and will be provided with an additional containment area around the temporary aboveground storage tanks. We will provide temporary gasoline and diesel piping from the temporary aboveground storage tanks to the existing 1.5" piping and it will be connected in a location where the piping transition to into the underground containment sump. We will provide ¾"hp. Submersible turbine pumps for each tank and we will provide temporary electric from the existing electric service on the existing aboveground storage tanks. We will make all temporary piping and electrical connections prior to the switch over to avoid any substantial delay during the switch over, however, the site should anticipate being inoperable for a period of up to 3 days. Our proposal includes all mobilization, demobilization and tank cleaning charges. The proposal includes 3 months of rental for all equipment. <p>Aurora is pleased to provide the following proposal for providing Code compliant emergency stop station. Our scope of work will include the installation of one (1) emergency stop station located on the existing power supply building and the installation of emergency stop station at the fueling island either inside or outside the existing kiosk. Our work will include the pulling of new power and control wire from the existing building to the existing kiosk. We will provide "shunt" trip main breaker which supplies power to the fuel island sub-panel. We will wire the emergency stop button to eliminated power at the fuel island by connecting power supply lines for the fuel pumps, dispensers, fuel management system and canopy lights to the emergency stop button which will when activated will eliminate power at the fuel station. The service emergency stop button will be installed on or inside the existing kiosk which will be installed in series with the emergency stop button located on the existing building. We will apply for local electrical permits and schedule all necessary inspections.
