RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - <u>211</u>

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TAX COLLECTOR OF THE CITY OF VINELAND TO EXTEND THE GRACE PERIOD FOR PAYMENT OF SECOND QUARTER 2020 TAX BILLS

WHEREAS, in light of the disruption caused and danger posed by the Coronavirus outbreak,"COVID-19." The Honorable Philip D. Murphy Governor of New Jersey has issued Executive Order No. 130 allowing for the extension of the Grace Period for Payment of Second Quarterly Installment of 2020 Taxes, concluding on date no later than June 1, 2020.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Vineland as follows:

1. The second quarter installment of 2020 taxes shall be due no later than June 1, 2020.

2. In the event the second quarter installment of the 2020 taxes, or any portion thereof, remains unpaid after the close of business, June 1, 2020, interest permitted in accordance with state and local laws and regulations shall be calculated from May 1, 2020 and shall continue to accrue on the unpaid taxes until the second quarter 2020 taxes are paid in full.

3. Pursuant to these facts, and circumstances, the City of Vineland Tax Collector is directed to extend the grace period for payment of second quarter 2020 tax bills to June 1, 2020.

4. The Clerk of the City of Vineland is directed to file certified copies of this Resolution, forthwith, with the City Auditor, Comptroller, Tax Collector, Business Administrator, Cumberland County Board of Taxation, and Director of the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs.
