

ORDINANCE NO. 2021- 16

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A LEFT TURN PROHIBITION WITH RESPECT TO THE DRIVEWAY OF THE S. DELSEA DRIVE AND W. SHERMAN AVENUE WAWA.

WHEREAS, the County of Cumberland has requested that the City establish an ordinance establishing a “Left Turn Prohibition” for the Wawa located at the southwest corner of Delsea Drive (NJ Route 47) and Sherman Avenue for traffic in and out of the driveway closest to S. Delsea Drive on W. Sherman Avenue; and

WHEREAS, said recommendation has been reviewed by the City Engineer’s Office, the Vineland Police Department and the City Solicitor, and is considered to be in the best interest of the City of Vineland;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Vineland as follows:

SECTION 1: Traffic westbound on Sherman Avenue shall not be permitted to negotiate a left turn so as to enter the Wawa property (at the driveway closest to Delsea Drive) located at the southwest corner of Delsea Drive and Sherman Avenue, also known as Block 7001, Lot 18, on the Tax Map of the City of Vineland.

Traffic northbound out of the Wawa property (at the driveway closest to Delsea Drive) shall not be permitted to negotiate a left turn westbound on Sherman Avenue, located at the southwest corner of Delsea Drive and Sherman Avenue, also known as Block 7001, Lot 18, on the Tax Map of the City of Vineland.

SECTION 2: Signs shall be erected and maintained as authorized by the Commissioner of Transportation of the State of New Jersey.

SECTION 3: All other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law and upon approval by the Cumberland County Board of Chosen Freeholders and the Commissioner of Transportation of the State of New Jersey.

SECTION 5: Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be subject to fines and penalties as set forth in the Code of the City of Vineland at Article II, §1-15.

**Left-Turn Prohibition**

Westbound on Sherman Avenue shall not be permitted to negotiate a left turn so as to enter the Wawa property (at the driveway closest to Delsea Drive) located at the southwest corner of Delsea Drive and Sherman Avenue, also known as Block 7001, Lot 18, on the Tax Map of the City of Vineland

Northbound out of the Wawa property (at the driveway closest to Delsea Drive) shall not be permitted to negotiate a left turn westbound on Sherman Avenue, located at the southwest corner of Delsea Drive and Sherman Avenue, also known as Block 7001, Lot 18, on the Tax Map of the City of Vineland
