1. The bid received by the Purchasing Agent of the City of Vineland on June 27, 2021, for the Installation of Carbon Monoxide Catalyst on Existing Down Unit 11 (Trent 60) Turbine, be and the same are hereby rejected.

2. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to immediately return to said bidder any bid bonds, certified checks, or other forms of security submitted by such bidder.

3. The Purchasing Agent of the City of Vineland is hereby authorized and directed to re-advertise for bids, at which time such bids submitted shall be publicly opened and read aloud.
