Stack Emissions and RATA Testing Services

A request for proposals for stack emissions and RATA testing was issued on November 9, 2021. The deadline for receipt of proposals was December 3, 2021. Proposals were received from Catalyst Air Management and Air Nova.

The specification requests unit prices for 14 different stack emission testing categories, three different CEMS RATA tests, and various miscellaneous tests and related activities including visual observations. The total number of annual emission and RATA tests along with visual observations that will be required during the 12 month period beginning on January 1, 2022 is unknown. If all of the various tests and visual observations are performed, the total aggregate amounts to be paid to each bidder would be:

Catalyst Air Management	\$516,872
Air Nova	\$293,890

Please be advised the number of emission tests and observations to be performed during 2022 is unknown and very likely considerably less than the number of tests for which unit prices were specified. Total annual expenditures for stack emissions and RATA testing are expected to be less than \$50,000.

The proposal from Air Nova was reviewed and found to be in full compliance with the specification. During the past twelve years, Air Nova has performed approximately 90% of the emissions testing for VMEU. The quality of their work has been excellent. Based on compliance with the specification, lowest proposal price, and past performance it is the considered opinion of Jeff Davis and Joe Colla that a 12 month contract commencing January 1, 2022 ending December 31, 2022 with an option for renew for one additional year be awarded to Air Nova.
