Project: Resurfacing of Landis Avenue Phase 6
Project \# 22-023
On behalf of the Engineering Division, please accept this memorandum as justification to award the Resurfacing of Landis Avenue Phase 6 project to the lowest bidder, South State Inc. In the past year, our department has been experiencing abnormal bid price increases to various construction materials including but not limited to concrete, asphalt, drainage infrastructure, and steel. Due to limited supply chains, high fuel costs, residual impacts from COVID \& inflation, and unprecedented long lead times on material deliveries averaging to up to four to six months, construction costs have been driven up significantly, and in many cases, unit prices have doubled. The cost estimate that was originally done for this project was completed before these impacts began to take place. In the provided engineering bid tabulation, most high cost line items between the contractors are within a reasonable difference. The estimated costs do not accurately reflect the recent impact on unit prices. If this project were to be rebid, it is our professional opinion that these bid prices will only marginally change, if not, at all. In order to avoid project delays and much longer material delivery lead times, it is our division's opinion to move forward with awarding South State Inc. the project.

Proposals were received and opened Tuesday, June 21, 2022 at 2:00 PM for Resurfacing of Landis Avenue, Phase 6 from the following:
South State, Inc: $\quad \$ 1,988,233.85$

Charles Marandino LLC: \$3,023,900.00

Comments: Both Bidders submitted all the mandatory documents.

Recommendation: The Using Department needs to closely look at both submissions as the lowest bid is approximately $\$ 700,000.00$ above the Engineer's Estimate and there is a difference of approximately $\$ 1,000,000.00$ between the two bidders which tends to show an unbalance not just between the 2 bidders but also both bidder's individual unit prices. Such an unbalance will be difficult to justify to the NJDOT for their approval.
