A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A CARLTON WOOD CHIPPER MODEL 2518 DRUM STYLE 18" FROM CHERRY VALLEY TRACTOR SALES, MARLTON, NJ, IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$79,900.00, PURSUANT TO A REGIONAL COOPERATIVE PRICING AGREEMENT WITH MIDDLESEX REGIONAL EDUCATIONAL SERVICES COMMISSION (MRESC) COOPERATIVE PRICING SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland Public Works is in need of a Wood chipper; and;

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland is a member of a Regional Cooperative Pricing Agreement known as the Middlesex Regional Educational Services Commission (MRESC) Cooperative Pricing System, #65 MCESCCPS; and,

WHEREAS, Middlesex Regional Educational Services Commission (MRESC) Cooperative Pricing System has acted as lead agency and awarded Contract #ESCNJ 18/19-25, for the purchase of a Carlton Wood Chipper Model 2518 Drum Style 18"; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2 permits the City of Vineland to purchase grounds equipment using the offered Regional Cooperative Pricing Agreement without public bidding, subject to the submittal and acceptance of certain documentation by Cherry Valley Tractor Sales; and

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland intends under MRESC, under the Category: Grounds Equipment, Contract ESCNJ 18/19-25, to purchase from Cherry Valley Tractor Sales, Marlton, NJ, a Carlton Wood Chipper Model 2518 Drum Style 18", in an amount not to exceed \$79,900.00, as listed in the Quotation, dated July 27, 2022, made available through MRESC; and

WHEREAS the Director of Public Works and the Qualified Purchasing Agent, with the concurrence of the Business Administrator, recommend the use of the Regional Cooperative Pricing through MRESC for this procurement;

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland Purchasing Agent has determined that the use of the offered Regional Cooperative Pricing Agreement will result in cost savings after all factors, including charges for service, material and delivery have been considered and has verified that such vehicle is not available through State Contract awarded by the Division of Purchase and Property in the New Jersey Department of the Treasury pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-12; and

WHEREAS, the availability of funds for said purchase to be awarded herein have been certified by the Chief Financial Officer; and

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland has certified that this meets the statute and regulations governing the award of said contracts;


