ORDINANCE NO. 2023-15

**ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2022-36,
AUTHORIZING THE HIRING OF POLICE OFFICERS
WITHOUT CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATION FOR
ENTRY LEVEL LAW ENFORCEMENT PURSUANT TO
N.J.S.A. 11A:4-1.3**

WHEREAS, on May 10, 2022, City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2022-36, authorizing the City to hire entry level police officers without the need to take the Civil Service examination as authorized by N.J.S.A. 11A:4-1.3 (Law); and

WHEREAS, the Law states that said waiver from the Civil Service requirement specifies that a person must successfully completes a full Basic Course for Police Officers training course at a school approved and authorized by the New Jersey Police Training Commission for a temporary entry-level officer by the municipality within nine months from the date of hire.,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Vineland that Ordinance 2022-36 be amended so as to require all persons seeking a position as a temporary entry-level officer with the City of Vineland complete a full Basic Course for Police Officers training course at a school approved and authorized by the New Jersey Police Training Commission within nine months from the date of hire by the City of Vineland.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the balance of Ordinance 2022-36 not amended hereby shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that should any portion of this Ordinance be deemed unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, that portion so determined to be unenforceable, shall be void and the balance hereof shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that should any Ordinance or portion thereof be inconsistent herewith, such Ordinance or portion thereof shall be void to the extent of such inconsistencies.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication according to law.
