A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2022-121, A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION TO THE NEW JERSEY URBAN ENTERPRISE ZONE AUTHORITY FOR FIRST GENERATION ENTERPRISE ZONE ASSISTANCE FUNDS FOR LANDIS AVENUE COMMERCIAL CORRIDOR CLEANING, MAINTENANCE AND BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT TO REFLECT AN INCREASE OF THE CITY'S CONTRIBUTION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$105,000.00 FOR EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, on April 12, 2022, City Council of the City of Vineland adopted Resolution 2022-121 authorizing an application to the New Jersey Urban Enterprise Zone Authority (Authority) for first Generation funds for Landis Avenue Commercial Corridor cleaning, maintenance and beautification (Project); and

WHEREAS, the request was for equipment in the amount \$275,000.00 and personnel in the amount of \$225,000.00; and

WHEREAS, it is now requested that the amount for equipment be amended for an additional \$105,000.00, for the purchase of 60 new trash cans for Landis Avenue, increasing the original amount from \$275,000.00 to \$380,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has heretofore deposited with all UEZ communities undistributed First Generation Funds to be used as the communities saw fit; and

WHEREAS, the CFO has certified the availability of funds from said account.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Vineland that Resolution 2022-121 be amended to reflect that the funds for the Landis Avenue Commercial Corridor Cleaning, Maintenance and Beautification shall be in an additional \$105,000.00 for equipment for the purchase of 60 new trash cans for Landis Avenue, shall be a local contribution from UEZ funds previously deposited with the City of Vineland.

Re: Amendment to Landis Ave. Corridor Project

City Council previously approved a resolution in June 2022 for the Landis Avenue Corridor project utilizing 1st generation UEZ funds in the amount of \$225,000 for salaries and fringes and previous UEZ funding given to the City in the amount of \$275,000 for equipment. The equipment amount from the City UEZ funds needs to be amended for an additional \$105,000 from the original amount of \$275,000 to \$380,000 to purchase 60 new trash cans for Landis Avenue.
