

**RESOLUTION NO. 2023- 249**

**A RESOLUTION DONATING EMERGENCY VEHICLE LIGHTS NO LONGER NEEDED BY THE CITY OF VINELAND TO THE TOWNSHIP OF CARNEY'S POINT IN ACCORDANCE WITH N.J.S.A. 40A:11-36**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Vineland has retrofitted several of its First Responder vehicles with new emergency vehicle lighting systems; and

**WHEREAS**, the lights changed out maintain a life expectancy of several years and are no longer needed for City use and the Township of Carney's Point has expressed a need and interest in acquiring the lights, which include 4 mirror lights, 2 grill lights, 2 tail lights, 4 windshield lights and 4 roof lights ; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-36 permits a municipality to transfer items of personality no longer needed for municipal purposes to another municipality at a nominal cost; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council finds it to be a gesture of good will to provide such equipment to communities within the State of New Jersey in need of such equipment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Vineland that certain emergency lights, to wit: 4 mirror lights, 2 grill lights, 2 tail lights, 4 windshield lights and 4 roof lights no longer needed by the City shall be donated to the Township of Carney's Point upon signing a Release of Liability regarding their use and serviceability.
