A RESOLUTION DONATING EMERGENCY VEHICLE LIGHTS NO LONGER NEEDED BY THE CITY OF VINELAND TO THE TOWNSHIP OF CARNEY'S POINT IN ACCORDANCE WITH N.J.S.A. 40A:11-36

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland has retrofitted several of its First Responder vehicles with new emergency vehicle lighting systems; and

WHEREAS, the lights changed out maintain a life expectancy of several years and are no longer needed for City use and the Township of Carney's Point has expressed a need and interest in acquiring the lights, which include 4 mirror lights, 2 grill lights, 2 tail lights, 4 windshield lights and 4 roof lights; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-36 permits a municipality to transfer items of personality no longer needed for municipal purposes to another municipality at a nominal cost; and

WHEREAS, City Council finds it to be a gesture of good will to provide such equipment to communities within the State of New Jersey in need of such equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Vineland that certain emergency lights, to wit: 4 mirror lights, 2 grill lights, 2 tail lights, 4 windshield lights and 4 roof lights no longer needed by the City shall be donated to the Township of Carney's Point upon signing a Release of Liability regarding their use and serviceability.
