NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that permission is hereby given to the Police Department to conduct the aforesaid public display of fireworks at the Vineland High School Complex, Chestnut Avenue and Brewster Road, on August 1, 2023, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 21:3-5.
