RESOLUTION EXERCISING OPTION TO EXTEND
CONTRACT C22-0137 FOR SUPPLYING AND
DELIVERING VOC-COMPLIANT HIGH PERFORMANCE
COLD PATCH.

WHEREAS, on October 25, 2022, City Council adopted Resolution No. 2022-449, awarding open-end contract to Richard E. Pierson Materials, Corp., Bridgeport, NJ for Supplying and Delivering VOC-Compliant High Performance Cold Patch, for the contract period September 1, 2022 through August 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the contract awarded through the Cumberland County Cooperative Pricing System, Identifier #181-CCCCPS BID #22-31, provided for an option to extend for one additional year; and

WHEREAS, the County through resolution has exercised the option to extend the contract for the additional year and as such, the City's Purchasing Agent is recommending that the City exercise said extension for the period September 1, 2023 through August 31, 2024, at the same terms and conditions (Pick-up: \$142.87/Ton and Supply/Deliver: \$142.87/Ton).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Vineland that Resolution No. 2022-449 is hereby amended to allow for the one year option renewal of Contract C22-0137, issued to Richard E. Pierson Materials, Corp., Bridgeport, NJ for Supplying and Delivering VOC-Compliant High Performance Cold Patch, for the period September 1, 2023 through August 31, 2024, at the same terms and conditions (Pick-up: \$142.87/Ton and Supply/Deliver: \$142.87/Ton).
