Bob Dickenson, Business Administrator:

The City's Engineering Division is requesting an ordinance to revise the No Passing Zone of East Avenue between Grant Avenue and Walnut Road. The City repaved East Avenue between Elmer Road and Walnut Road in 1992. This was just a mill and resurface project with no changes to horizontal or vertical alignment. The reason for this request is residential development since the survey was last completed.

East Avenue was last surveyed in 1995 (NPZ-3596) and contains two new intersections: Pleasant Drive and Amanda Court. East Avenue between Elmer Road and Grant Avenue was not dedicated to the City of Vineland. Also, several new residential subdivisions have sprouted in the area creating additional traffic volumes on East Avenue and its intersecting streets.

Attached for your information is a copy of the revised No Passing Zone map (dated September 14, 2023) for East Avenue between Grant Avenue and Walnut Road.


