AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE INTERSECTION OF PANTHER ROAD AND DANTE AVENUE AS A FOUR-WAY STOP INTERSECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VINELAND, THAT:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-140, the following intersection is hereby designated as a four-way stop intersection. The intersection is currently a 2-Way Stop with Dante Avenue being the stop-controlled roadway. Stop signs shall also be installed on Panther Road

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Request for New Stop Intersection Ordinance

Bob Dickenson, Business Administrator:

Due to a few recent serious crashes as well as resident concerns, the Engineering Division conducted a study to determine the need for a 4-Way STOP at the intersection of Panther Road and Dante Avenue. The intersection is currently a 2-Way STOP with Dante Avenue being the stop-controlled roadway.

To determine if the installation of a 4-Way STOP is warranted, a study was conducted to determine if the intersection met the current Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) warrant requirements for traffic volume and crash experience. The study is enclosed for your use.

The intersection does meet MUTCD warrant criteria for vehicular volume and crashes. Therefore, a 4-Way STOP is recommended at this intersection for the following reasons:

- a. The severity and frequency of the crashes at the intersection,
- b. High vehicular speeds,
- c. The side street (stop approach) having approximately the same amount of traffic as the through street (51%/49%).
- d. The total measured volume for both Panther Road (247 vehicles) and Dante Avenue (244 vehicles per hour), met the MUTCD minimum for an 8 hour period for the major and minor approaches.

Please prepare an Ordinance establishing a Stop Sign on Panther Road as follows:

Also, a Work Order will be submitted to Public Works to remove existing Intersection Ahead signs as well as install new STOP signs and STOP Ahead signs on Panther Road. 24" white stop bars and transverse rumble strips will also be installed (by a Contractor) on both approaches of Panther Road at the intersection of Dante Avenue.
