A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH DEBLASIO & ASSOCIATES, WILDWOOD, NJ, IN CONNECTION WITH ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE DESIGN OF N. EAST AVENUE FROM LANDIS AVENUE TO PARK AVENUE.

WHEREAS, there exists a need for professional engineering services in connection with the design of N. East Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City of Vineland has a need to acquire such professional engineering services as a Non-Fair and Open Contract pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5; and

WHEREAS, DeBlasio & Associates, Wildwood, NJ, has submitted a proposal indicating they will provide the professional services in an amount not to exceed \$45,000.00 for a period six (6) months from date of award; and

WHEREAS, DeBlasio & Associates has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification for Non-Fair and Open Contract which certifies that DeBlasio & Associates has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the City of Vineland in the previous one year and that the contract will prohibit DeBlasio & Associates from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract to a political or candidate committee in the City of Vineland; and


WHEREAS, the availability of funds for said Professional Services Contract to be awarded herein have been certified by the Chief Financial Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contract Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq) requires that the Resolution authorizing the award of contract for Professional Services without competitive bidding and the contract itself must be available for public inspection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Vineland as follows:

- 1. That the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute a Non-Fair and Open Agreement pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5 with DeBlasio & Associates, Wildwood, NJ, for Professional Engineering Services in connection with the design of N. East Avenue from Landis Avenue to Park Avenue, in an amount not to exceed \$45,000.00.
- 2. That this Agreement is awarded without competitive bidding as a Professional Services in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a) of the Local Public Contracts Law because said services to be rendered or performed require knowledge of an advanced type in a field of learning acquired by a prolonged formal course of specialized instruction distinguished from general academic instruction or apprenticeship and training.
- 3. That the Business Disclosure Entity Certification and the Political Contribution Disclosure Form be placed on file with the Resolution.
- 4. That a Notice of this action shall be printed once in the Daily Journal.

IV. Bidding and Award

- c. Attend the bid opening.
- Review and tabulate bids.
- e. Provide analysis of the bids and make recommendations for awarding the contract.

AWARD JUSTIFICATION

N. EAST AVENUE DESIGN

The City Engineer's office intends to award a contract for design of N. East Avenue from Landis Avenue to Park Avenue to DeBlasio & Associates. Originally, the intention was to hire a consultant for survey and use that information to perform design with in-house staff. Due to internal workload coupled with the need to have the design completed within a certain timeframe, it became apparent that contracting the design would be beneficial.

DeBlasio & Associates was previously hired to perform the survey of the roadway. This work has been completed and the survey has been delivered to the City with the understanding that the City was going to perform the design in-house with this product.

If another design firm was to perform the design, they would be required to obtain permission from the surveyor of record to utilize the digital version of the survey or send their own survey crew to collect the data anew. It is my belief that any such permission or recollection would be cost-prohibitive in this circumstance. The cost of the survey coupled with the quote provided for design amounts to approximately 8.6% of the preliminary construction cost estimate. This is within industry norms. I recommend award for design to DeBlasio & Associates.
