The proposed renewal program charges provided below do not account for any Federal and/or State government programs, fees, taxes or regulations including, but not limited to, the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act with the exception of certain preventive health services and coverage for dependents to the age 26. The proposed renewal program charges also assume that the present benefit design, co-pay structure, and participation level will remain unchanged. Should any of these factors change during the contract period, Benecard reserves the right to revise these program charges. The proposed program charges include insurance carrier charges by Heartland Fidelity Insurance Company. These charges guarantee program costs by the carrier for the contract period.

Weight Loss Medications Cost Savings Alternatives

As a result of social media influencers touting the use of certain weight loss medications for physical appearance purposes, we have seen over the past year and on a national level, the dramatic increase in the use and cost of weight loss injectable medications (Wegovy and Saxenda). These two medications in particular are expected to continue to rise in utilization as the pharmaceutical manufacturer for both of these drugs is seeking FDA approval for their oral tablet form which if approved could likely be available to the marketplace by the end of 2024. Benecard is closely monitoring the usage of these medications to ensure members are adhering to the prescribing guidelines set forth by the manufacturer's drug label and FDA. If the City removed coverage of all weight loss medications from their prescription plan, it would result in a savings of approximately 4.9%. Benecard also has the ability to add step therapy specifically to just weight loss medications as another alternative. An alternative can be provided to reflect these savings as well whether including grandfathering or no grandfathering. Please reach out to me should you wish to see these alternatives as well.

¹ The Affordable Care Act requires the City of Vineland's health benefits program implement an out-of-pocket (OOP) limit to protect individuals from excessive OOP expenses on all essential health benefits on or after January 1, 2015. The OOP limits represented above are based on the City of Vineland's request to have a separate prescription OOP and at these required dollar limits effective January 1, 2024. It is our understanding that the City of Vineland's acceptance of this proposal is based on their request to have a separate OOP limit combined with all other essential health benefit OOP limits that does not exceed the annual limitation on the OOP's for that year as outlined by the Department of Labor. The Rx OOP limits are subject to change if the ACA OOP limits are modified. Benecard reserves the right to revise the City of Vineland's prescription benefit program charges if the client modifies or implements a different copayment level, coinsurance, deductible or any other benefit design change, including a change to the OOP amount that differs from what was used for underwriting purposes to develop for the program charges provided herein or enacts a change after inception of the new contract start date.
