WHEREAS, the City of Vineland has certified that this meets the statute and regulations governing the award of said contracts.

#### Introduction



### - Utility Business Plan

- Work with Broadband Utility staff to create runbooks for both Network startup and continuing operations tasks.
- o Identify financing solution for Network construction and early-stage operations.

- o Discuss the feasibility, potential risks, and benefits associated with each step of the process and work with Vineland to streamline efforts towards completion.
- o Provide expert recommendations and strategic insights on the most viable steps forward.
- Ad-hoc strategic guidance and advice during the broadband utility stand-up process.
- Regular communication, progress updates and consultation with the Vineland team throughout the project duration.
- o Timely responses to queries and requests for review, opinions, meetings, etc.

### - RFP Management

- Develop Request for Proposal (RFP) documents for both Network Engineering and Network Construction
- o End-to-end management of RFP response process including:
  - Selection of invited applicants.
  - Coordination, meetings, and questions/answers with respondents.

- The scope of work under this consulting engagement is to be completed by 12/31/24.
   Additional work necessary in Q1 or Q2 of 2025 may occur but will need to be priced out separately and will result in additional costs under a new contract.
- Bonfire and Vineland to continue meeting "bi-weekly" with additional meetings occurring throughout the engagement as deemed necessary.
- The engagement has been priced as an "All-In" cost and is to be billed at a monthly rate for the length of the contract (assuming new contract begins in April 2024). Invoices will be sent out at the end of each month through December 2024.
  - o \$10,058.30 Per Month.
- Net 30 Day payment terms.
