

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-35

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR NO PARKING RESTRICTIONS ALONG A PORTION OF N. SECOND STREET.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking should be prohibited along a portion of N. Second Street between W. Pear Street and W. Peach Street due to the existing location of the Vineland Municipal Electric Utility Unit 11 fuel unloading zone along this roadway behind the edge of pavement; and

WHEREAS, currently vehicles have been parking within the unloading zone, which is a safety hazard and also prevent access for emergency vehicles at this site; and

WHEREAS, said recommendation has the concurrence of the Vineland Police Department and the City Solicitor and is considered to be in the best interest of the City of Vineland; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VINELAND THAT:

SECTION 1. No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets:

Name of Street	Side	Location
Second Street	West	Between W. Pear Street and W. Peach Street

SECTION 2. Signs shall be erected and maintained as authorized by the Commissioner of Transportation of the State of New Jersey.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.


Please take note that there is a need to restrict parking on the west side of N. Second Street between W. Pear Street and W. Peach Street. Vineland Electric Utility has the Howard M. Down Generating Station (Unit 11) located along this roadway. There is an existing fuel unloading zone behind the edge of pavement. Electric Utility staff have observed vehicles parked within this unloading zone, which is also a safety hazard. The parked vehicles near this location also prevent access for emergency vehicles at this site.

As such, please prepare an Ordinance establishing No Parking along Second Street as follows:
