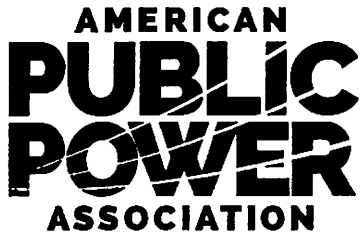

- elevating impacts of supply chain constraints to electric sector.


