

PRE-MEETING CONFERENCE

The Pre-Meeting Conference of the City Council of the City of Vineland was called to order by the President, Anthony R. Fanucci.

The Deputy Municipal Clerk stated Public Notice of this meeting, pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act, has been given on December 15, 2014 by the City Clerk in the following manner:

President Fanucci asked if anyone from the public would like to comment.

Tony Centeno voiced his concern and objection about motorcycles not being permitted to participate in the recent VDID car event on Landis Avenue. He said motorcycles were allowed at past events, but the organizers decided last year to exclude them this year. He believes he has a right to participate as a Vineland taxpayer. Apparently, the event is not directly conducted by the VDID, and the organizers – if they follow the ordinance – may set the rules for participation in their event.

The Deputy Clerk reviewed the changes to the agenda since the June 1 work session. Resolution No. 2015-244, authorizing the transfer of taxicab owners licenses, was added.

Councilman Spinelli reported that at a Recreation Commission meeting last night, it was noted that cracks are appearing in the track at the Romano complex. Superintendent Elbeuf is coordinating the solution. Also, water damage at the Senior Center is being checked by City Engineer Brian Myers before painting.
