PRE-MEETING CONFERENCE TUESDAY, MAY 28, 2019 6:00 P.M.

The Pre-Meeting Conference of the City Council of the City of Vineland was called to order by the President, Paul F. Spinelli.

President Spinelli led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Municipal Clerk stated Public Notice of this meeting, pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act, has been given on December 12, 2018 by the City Clerk in the following manner:

President Spinelli asked if anyone from the public would like to comment.

Steve Lewis commented that the Memorial Day service was wonderful. He took issue, however, with the need to remove flowers and flags because of concerns with theft and/or vandalism. He suggested that a security camera be installed to catch would-be perpetrators. He also suggested a monument honoring those who served in the more recent Middle East conflicts.

Tony Centeno stated the Memorial Day parade was great, but there should be an effort to get more participation in it.

The Clerk reviewed changes to the agenda since the May 21 work session. The resolution recognizing Andrew Biddinger upon retiring was removed because he is not retiring. Resolution No. 2019-206 was assigned to a resolution granting the renewal of alcoholic beverage licenses for the licensing period July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020. The resolution authorizing the execution of an agreement with Paymentech LLC, Salem, New Hampshire, for payment processing services was removed from the agenda because of no pay-to-play documents being received. Resolution No. 2019-210 was assigned to a resolution amending Resolution 2018-503, a resolution adopting a cash management plan for the City of Vineland in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:5-14. A revised version of Resolution No. 2019-219 was distributed to correct the error and clarify that it is a 4-wheel drive vehicle. A revised version of Resolution No. 2019-230 was provided to add an omitted word in the body of the resolution.

The Clerk reminded everyone that the Health Department will be recognizing the winners of the food safety calendar posters tonight and noted that next week's work session will be on Monday because of the Primary Election to be conducted on Tuesday.
