Joan Giacondo wanted to state on the record that she was totally against the development of Weymouth Road exampling potential harmful environmental impact, more traffic to the area. She stated clustered housing does not benefit this area.

Carrie Wiener stated she strongly opposed the property being developed. This lake leads to the environmentally sensitive Maurice River and it would be a huge mistake to sell any land on that property. Development will add to the traffic in the community. Our school system already requires children to walk to schools over a ½ mile away. They have bus stops with no shoulders on the road. It wont benefit by adding another 500 vehicles. COV big mistake if they don't listen to those that are for the environmental. Mistake to add a development to this property.

Cheryl Fox from Weymouth Road stated the natural resources this area has and contributes to the Maurice River, she is opposed to development by the City of Vineland for this property. With development, people will not be able to enjoy our great outdoors. She is opposed to any changes the City wants to take on concerning this property.

Joe Giacondo from Vineland stated he hopes the City of Vineland looks into the property owner who is selling the land to the City as he has no concern for the environment and the lake rather than to just look at the money his is waving in front of the City. Housing in this area will be very overpriced and out of place for this area. He stated this northern area of Vineland seems to get all the trash in part of town.

Katie Rogan was concerned 50 years from now rather than the short economic gain. The City must think of the long term future and forestry. NJ was known for its greenery but not so much now. Developments are losing value and creating eye-sores and it won't be good for this area.

President Spinelli voiced his concern over the environmental impact of the area if the Ordinance was passed and wanted to ensure the City had done its due diligence. Supervising Planner, Kathie Hicks and Chief Engineer, Ryan Headley were present to speak on the City's behalf. Ms. Hicks stated this is the 3<sup>rd</sup> time in 15 years the City received requests for a large Active Adult Community. Environmentally speaking, the Maurice River begins at the Millville dam and goes South. This is the upper reaches. There is environmentally sensitive area as far as DEP maps are concerned. The City does not address that. The DEP addresses all those issues. Any amendment/development to this area will ultimately have to go before the DEP with proper permits. Ms. Hicks wrote into this Ordinance that any development must come with an environmental impact and water impact statement, a traffic impact statement and it must have both public water and sewer to proceed or it's a "no go" situation. Preservation to this property can't prevent development to this property unless it's done by a non-profit or non-governmental entity. Mr. Headley spoke about the sensitively to the lake and the storm water management and commented there currently is no site plan in place. He stated the only thing this Ordinance does is change the use to the area. Any development would need to go through a site design approval process. The DEP has requirements the City must adopt concerning storm water best management practices and those regulations are constantly evolving to minimize the environmental impact. Since 2004, it has been shown these types of developments actually incur a betterment to communities rather than those that were developed in previous years without certain regulations and benchmarks.
