The Pre-Meeting Conference of the City Council of the City of Vineland was called to order by the President, Paul F. Spinelli.

There being no one to be heard, the Clerk reviewed revisions and additions to the agenda. Ordinance No. 2020-55, An ordinance authorizing the execution of a real property purchase and sales agreement by and between Garden State Highway Products, Inc., Millville, NJ and the City of Vineland for the acquisition of Block 1909, Lot 56, was added. Resolution No. 2020-437, A resolution opposing the release of prisoners in Cumberland County jails as directed by Governor Murphy in accordance with S2519 unless released back to the counties in which they were sentenced to jail instead of releasing them in Cumberland County, was added.

The Clerk reminded Council members that next week's work session is scheduled for Monday, because of Tuesday's election.

Councilman Franceschini reported that the Health Department is conducting a flu vaccine clinic at the Vineland Flea Market. This will serve as a trial for any COVID vaccine, when such vaccine is ready. COVID-19 numbers are increasing again. He also noted that pre-schools return to full-time beginning November 8.
