Currently there is a surge of positive cases in New Jersey, slowing the resumption of normal activities. There is also an effort to get many more teachers vaccinated.

Councilman Vargas announced that PAL is accepting names for their summer camp program. He also noted the upcoming annual Easter Egg Hunt at various city parks on Saturday, March 27, with a rain date of Saturday, April 3. He also publicly thanked Councilman Spinelli's wife, Josie, for her seasonal decorations around City Hall.

Councilman Spinelli reported that Landis Theater continues with sell-out shows. Their events are 50% of capacity. The VDID car show, food truck festival and the 'Old Fashioned Christmas' are all being planned. He also appreciates the efforts from Mr. Lewis and the city staff and City Council to advance the Gold Star family utility discount program.

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Solicitor Tonetta concurred about the quality and professionalism of the Landis Theater shows.

President Arthur noted the upcoming promotion of police officer Platania to Sergeant.

The President entertained a motion by Councilman Acosta, and seconded by Councilman Franceschini, to adjourn the meeting.
